To run for State Representative, you must file between 6/1/22 and 6/10/22 at the Town Clerks office. Even if you are not interested in running this year, but might want to consider running in future years it is worth your while to stop by one of our sessions.

Preserving Election Integrity

You can volunteer to work at the polls on Election days for both the primary in September and the General Election in November. All of these positions require training, so you need to sign up soon.

Local Boards and Commissions
